# Weight tolerance

1kg weight tolerance is allowed for each category.

#### Competition system

Double repechage or pool competition system.

2 entries will be combined with the next weight class above.

3-5 entries single pool, 6-7 entries, double pool.

8 and more entries, repechage competition system.

Match length is 4 minutes.

### Blue and white judogis is required.

Every competitor must have an international insurance for injures. No insurance is provided by the organizers.
